A year later, false reports of Rep. Giffords death still reverberate for the press

A year ago today I was sitting on my couch watching TV and casting a casual eye to TweetDeck. I don't remember how I learned that something tragic was unfolding in Arizona. I do remember people retweeting the NPR report that Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords had died. From there, I watched conflicting reports flow past as journalists and others worked to sort through the misinformation.

It soon became clear to me: I had to capture this.

I began putting together a Storify to record the confusion about her fate, and to illustrate how things were unfolding in real-time. (It's embedded at the bottom of this post.) It was tough to keep up, to pick out the tweets that best represented each milestone as the story worked itself out.

Twitter gave me a window into the captivating mixture of urgency, confusion and information that emerges when major news breaks and the story takes off.

The F.B.I. Criticizes the News Media After Several Mistaken Reports of an Arrest

The <u>F.B.I.</u> scolded several news outlets on Wednesday for mistakenly reporting that an arrest had been made in the <u>Boston Marathon</u> bombings, and warned that such unverified reporting could have "unintended consequences" for its investigation.

Numerous organizations, including The Associated Press, <u>The Boston Globe</u> and several local Boston television stations, erroneously reported Wednesday afternoon that an arrest had been made, or that a suspect was in custody, citing unnamed law enforcement sources. Two of the reports came from CNN and the Fox News Channel, both the subject of widespread criticism last June after misreporting the result of the Supreme Court ruling on President Obama's health care overhaul law.

CNN and Fox News spent about an hour discussing the news of an arrest with various correspondents and experts before backing off when they received further information.

NBC News held back on reporting news of an arrest during continuing coverage on its MSNBC cable channel. It reported that no arrest had been made and that no person had been firmly identified as under suspicion.

In the past, PolitiFact has received funding from the Ford Foundation, Craigslist Charitable Fund and the Collins Center for Public Policy.
